

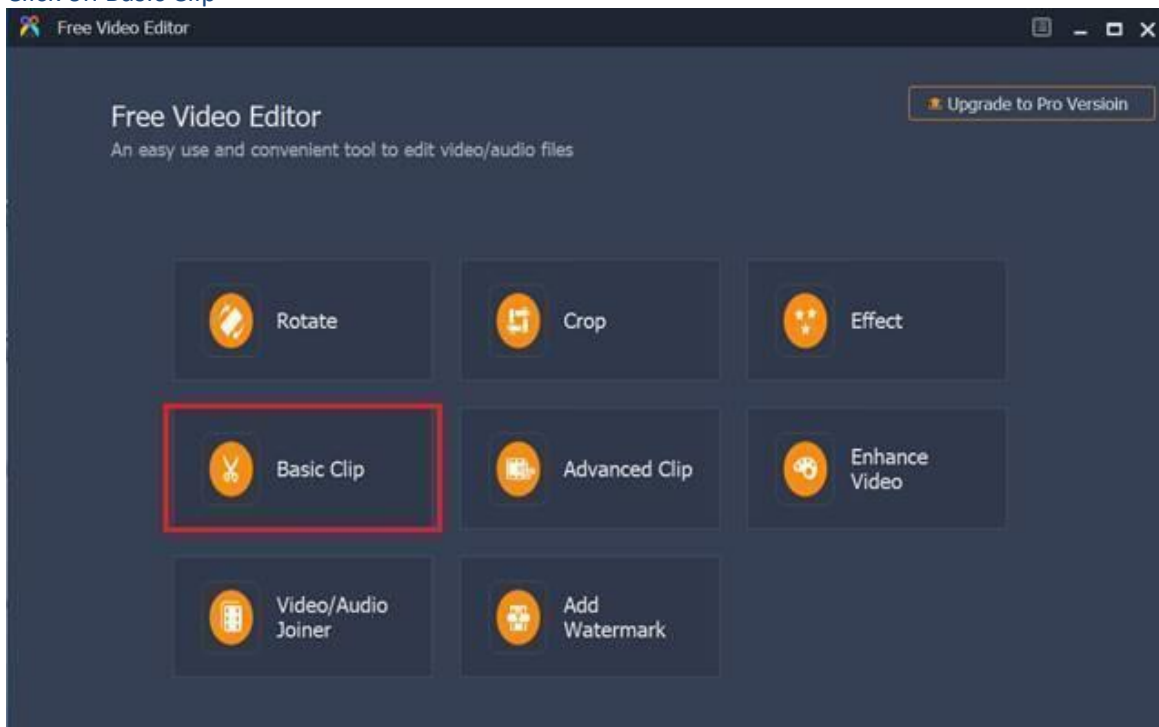
If you want to edit the zoom\_0.mp4 recording before uploading to Kaltura My Media:

And download, then install, the Free video editor

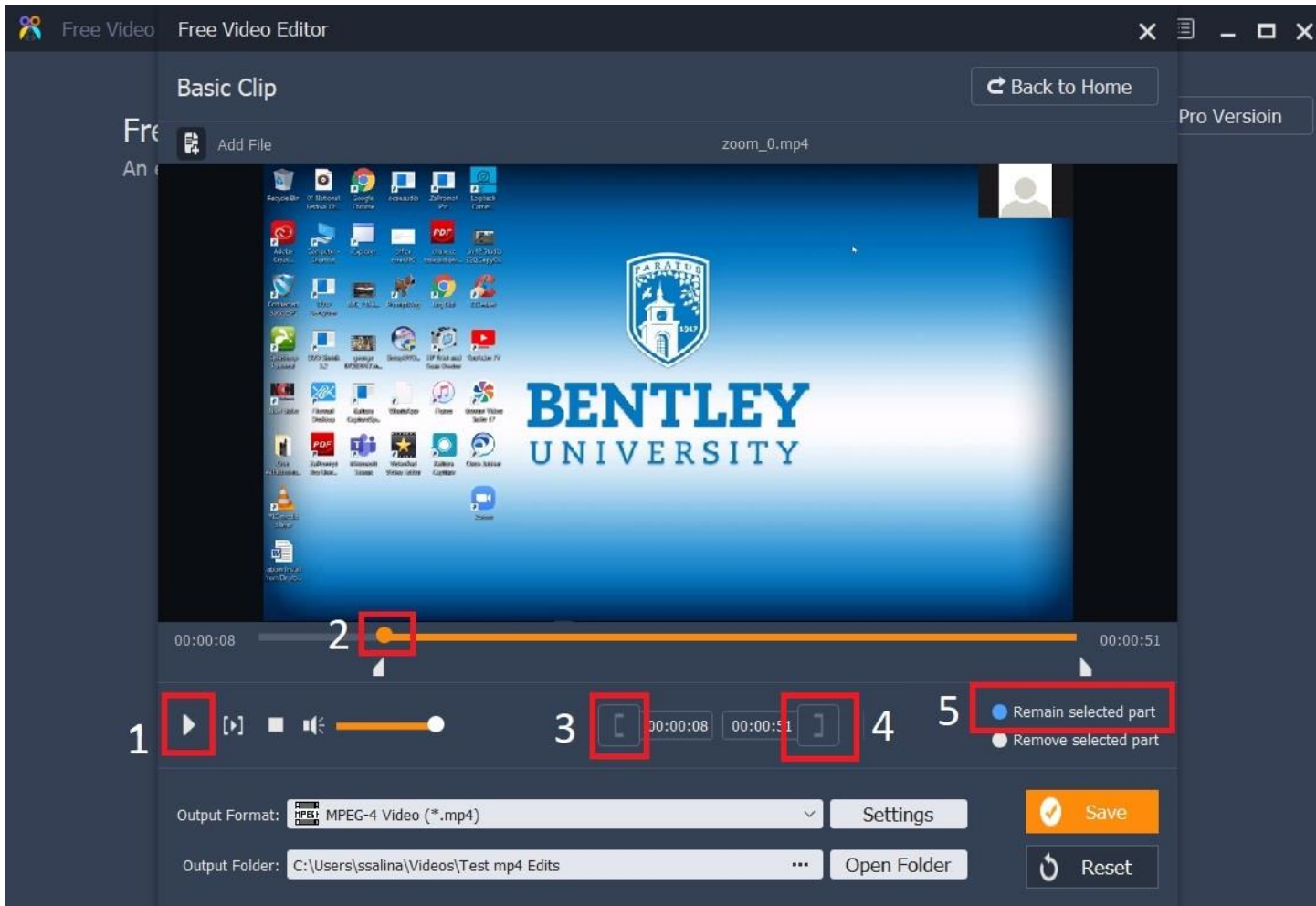
Once you have it installed, run the program.

1. Click on Basic Clip



2. Click on Add file, and add your mp4 file

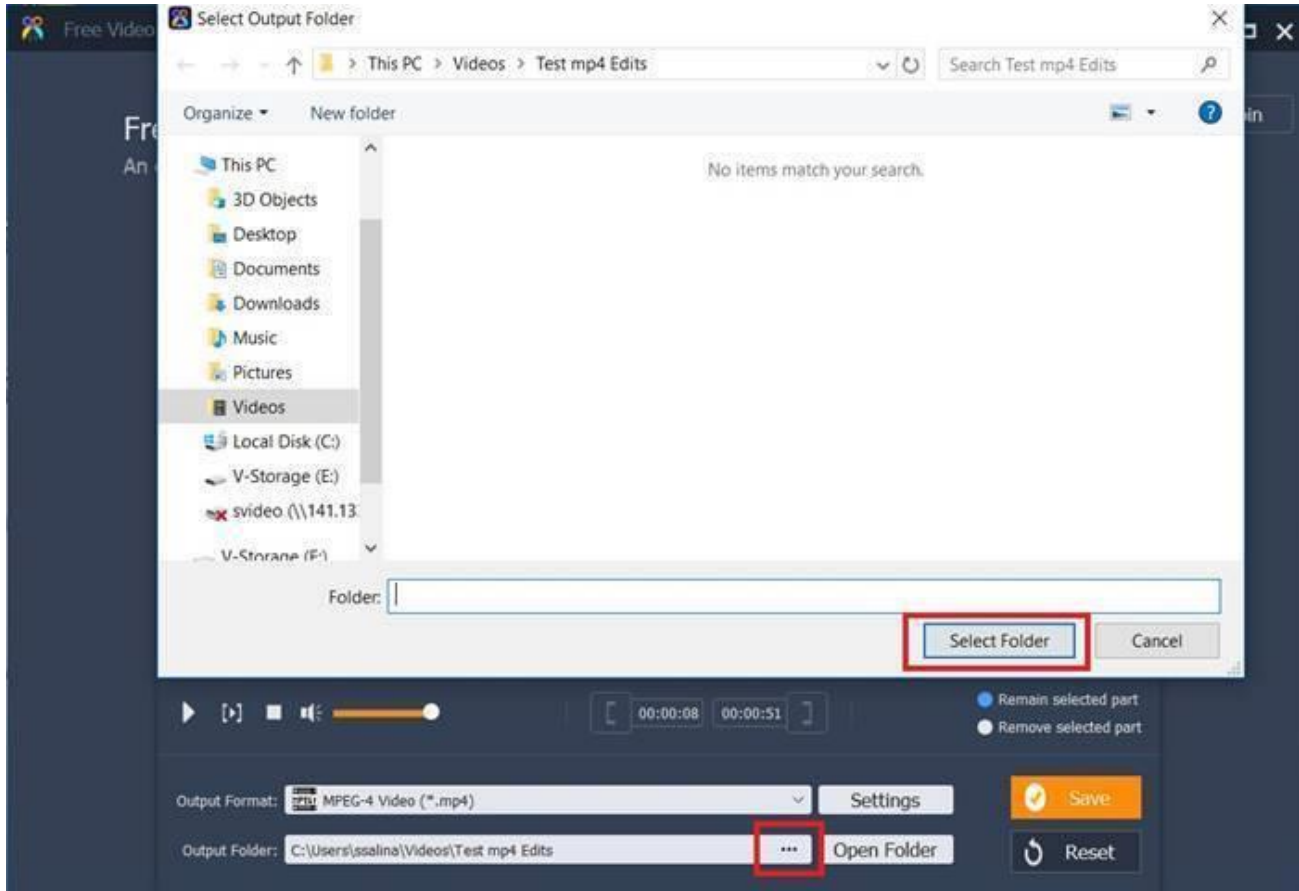
3. Click on the play button (1) to start playing your video, or click and drag the orange playhead (2) to approximately where you'd like your video to start. Then click play, and pause it at the new start point of your video. Click the Set Start Point button (3) to set the new start point. Make sure "Remain Selected Part" (5) is selected.



a. If you want to set an end point as well:

Click on the play button (1) to start playing your video, or click and drag the orange playhead (2) to approximately where you'd like your video to start. Then click play, and pause it at the new start point of your video. Click the Set Start Point button (3) to set the new start point. Then, Click on the play button (1) to start playing your video, or click and drag the orange playhead (2) to approximately where you'd like your video to end. Then click play, and pause it at the new end point of your video. Click the Set End Point button (4) to set the new end point. Make sure "Remain Selected Part" (5) is selected.

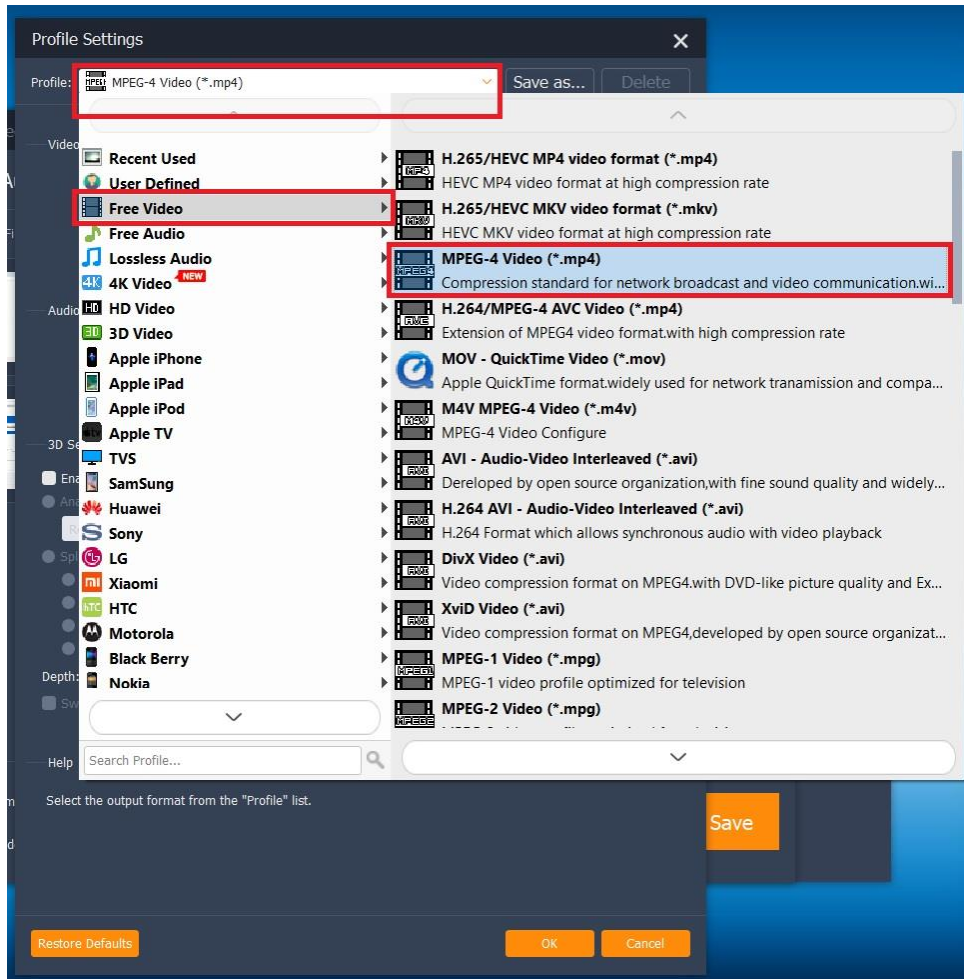
4. Click the three dots next to Open Folder to select where you'd like to save the video. The Select Output Folder will open. Select the appropriate folder, and click Select Folder.



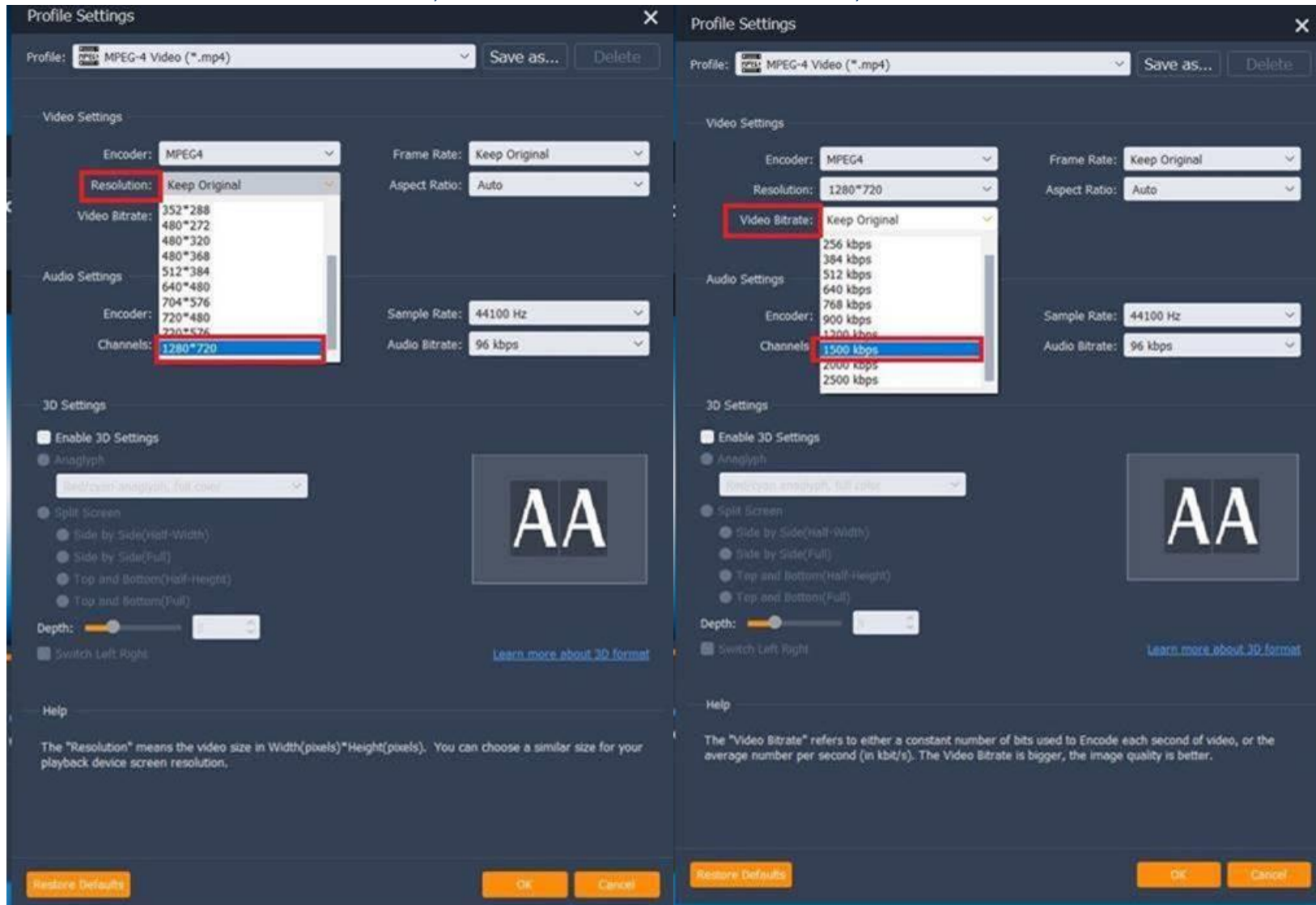
5. Click on Settings next to Output Format



a. Click Profile and choose Free Video>MPEG-4



b. Click Resolution and choose 1280x720, and Click Video Bitrate and select 1500, then click OK



6. Click Save



You'll now have an edited mp4 version of your file. You can then upload those clips to Kaltura/My Media via Blackboard.
